


SPLIT-SPECIMEN CUP™ PROCEDURE CARD




Donor removes Cap. (Key is held by technician).




Donor provides specimen and secures Cap tightly.




Technician dates and initials the Security Seal and places Security Seal over Cap.




Technician places Cup on a flat surface, inserts Key and pushes in.











Read Adulteration test results between 2 - 5 minutes.



Read Drug Strips at 5 minutes.




Example: test shows positive for PCP



Read results at 5 minutes


